

# Directions to DAFF Laboratories, Backweston, Celbridge, Co. Kildare.

**CO-ORDINATES:-** NORTH - 53<sup>0</sup>. 20'. 526''; WEST - 006<sup>0</sup> 30'.0041''

## **From Dublin City Centre**

1. Travelling from Dublin City Centre you take the N4 in the direction of The West-Sligo/Galway
2. Continue past the Liffey Valley Shopping Centre on your left
3. Proceed along the N4 for about 4 miles (under a flyover), until you see the Spa Hotel on the left.
4. Shortly after the Spa Hotel you will see signs for a slip road to Celbridge and Leixlip; take this slip road, which leads up to a T-junction, turn left at this junction, signposted to Celbridge.
5. Approximately a mile along this road you will see Weston Aerodrome on the right. Continue about another mile and you will come to a set of traffic lights, with the laboratory complex visible on the left.
6. Turn left at the traffic lights.
7. The Laboratory Complex is the first entrance on the left (after approximately 400 meters).
8. Inside the entrance gate there is an access control barrier where you will need to "check in" with security.
9. Ask for directions to the DAFF Laboratories.

## **From the North (via M1 / M50)**

- Follow the M50 orbital motorway south.
- Pass the N3 and once over the bridge over the Liffey immediately take the slip road off the M50 (Junction 7) to the N4 i.e. Sligo/Galway Road.
- Go around the "roundabout" to the N4 westbound (signposted for Lucan/ Maynooth/ Sligo/Galway). Continue past the Liffey Valley Shopping Centre on your left
- Proceed along the N4 for about 4 miles (under a flyover), until you see the Spa Hotel on the left.
- Shortly after the Spa Hotel you will see signs for a slip road to Celbridge and Leixlip; take this slip road, which leads up to a T-junction, turn left at this junction, signposted to Celbridge.
- Approximately a mile along this road you will see Weston Aerodrome on the right. Continue about another mile and you will come to a set of traffic lights, with the laboratory complex visible on the left.
- Turn left at the traffic lights.
- The Laboratory Complex is the first entrance on the left (after approximately 400 meters).
- Inside the entrance gate there is an access control barrier where you will need to "check in" with security.
- Ask for directions to the DAFF Laboratories.

**From the South** (via M11 / M50 )

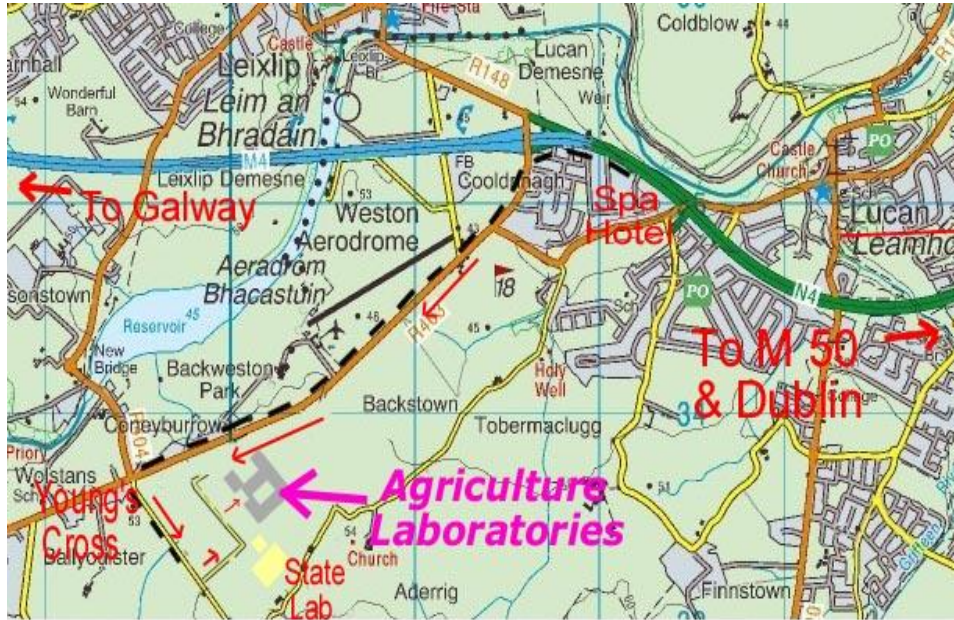
- Travel north on the M50 to junction 7 and take the slip road signposted for Lucan/ Maynooth/Sligo/ Galway.
- Continue past the Liffey Valley Shopping Centre on your left
- Proceed along the N4 for about 4 miles (under a flyover), until you see the Spa Hotel on the left.
- Shortly after the Spa Hotel you will see signs for a slip road to Celbridge and Leixlip; take this slip road, which leads up to a T-junction, turn left at this junction, signposted to Celbridge.
- Approximately a mile along this road you will see Weston Aerodrome on the right. Continue about another mile and you will come to a set of traffic lights, with the laboratory complex visible on the left.

**From the West** (via M4 / N4 )

- Pass the Maynooth, Celbridge South interchange.
- Take the slip road signed for Celbridge and Leixlip and travel right (over N4 carriageway) and straight through traffic lights towards Celbridge.
- Approximately a mile along this road you will see Weston Aerodrome on the right. Continue about another mile and you will come to a set of traffic lights, with the laboratory complex visible on the left.
- Turn left at the traffic lights.
- The Laboratory Complex is the first entrance on the left.
- Inside the entrance gate there is an access control barrier where you will need to "check in" with security.
- Ask for directions to the DAFF Laboratories.
