NOTIFICATION OF EVENTS

The Terms and Conditions of REPS 4 are amended as follows:

13. Amendments to Plans

Paragraph 13.2 is amended as follows:


Participants are required to notify the local office of the Department as follows:


- (i) By completing and lodging the prescribed form within 6 weeks of the commencement date of the following events: -
 - Where the contract area is reduced by less than 2 hectares.
 - Where organic fertiliser is imported or exported.

- (ii) By completing and lodging the prescribed form prior to the following events:-
 - Grazing of livestock owned by others on participant's farm, or grazing by livestock owned by participant on another farm.
 - Housing and feeding of livestock owned by others on participant's farm, or housing and feeding of livestock owned by participant on another farm

Amended forms are now available on the Department website and must be used from the date of this circular:

Form G – Confirmation of short term movement of livestock
Form H – Confirmation of short term renting of farm buildings
Form W – Record of movement of organic fertilisers.
