The Terms and Conditions of REPS 4 are amended as follows:

**13. Amendments to Plans**


The second bullet point of paragraph 13.1 is amended as follows:

where the annual stocking density for a recording year as set out in the REPS plan is to increase/decrease to such a degree that a change in fertiliser use is warranted in accordance with the Teagasc publication *Major and Micro Nutrient Advice for Productive Agricultural Crops, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition 2008*, or any amendments thereof.

In the Penalty Schedule, the last item under *Measure 1* Nutrient Management Plan is replaced by:
