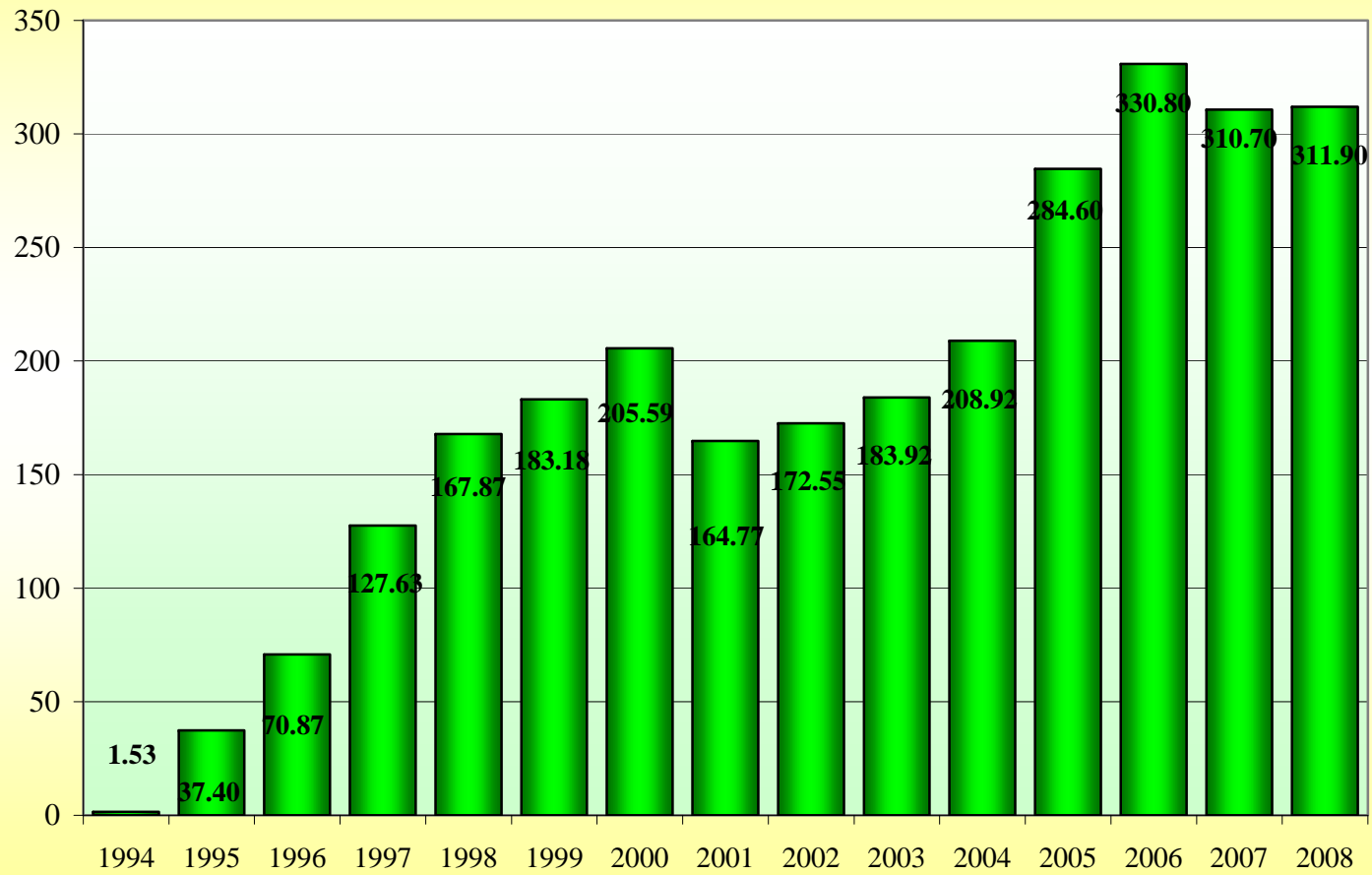

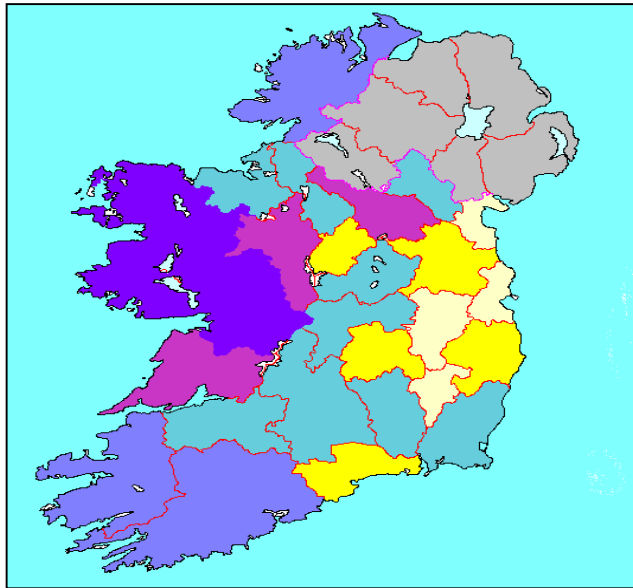

TOTALS PAID UNDER REPS 1994-2008



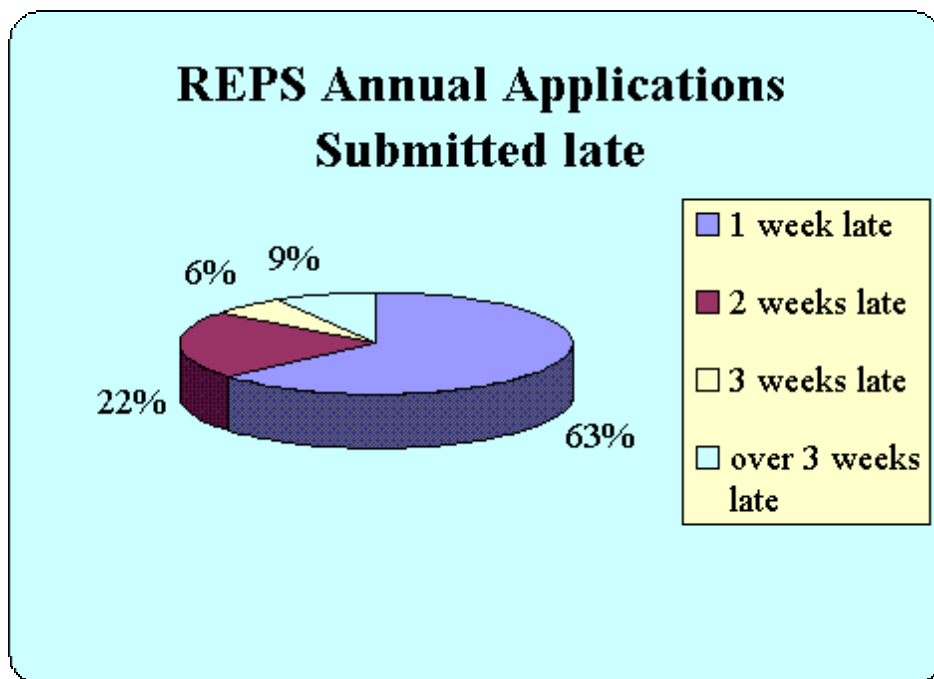
GEOGRAPHICAL SPREAD OF REPS PARTICIPANTS
