The Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources, (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister"), in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 15 of the Fisheries (Consolidation), Act, 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), hereby authorises, subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule to this licence,

(hereinafter referred to as "the Licensee"):

1. To perform all operations necessary for the cultivation of salmon and rainbow trout in six (6) wooden cages 5.8m x 5.8m x 3m and in two (2) wooden cages 7.0m x 7.0m x 3.0m having a combined cubic capacity of 900 metres placed in that area of Knappaghbeg Lake shown on the map annexed hereto.
2. To purchase, have in possession and sell live salmon ova, fry, fingerlings or smolts and rainbow trout ova, fry and fingerlings acquisition of which has been approved by the Minister;
3. To capture and have in possession within the confines of the said rearing unit salmon ova, fry, fingerlings or smolts and rainbow trout ova, fry or fingerlings at any time of the year;
4. For the management of the said rearing unit to have in possession and use nets, traps, or such engines as may be approved from time to time by the Minister.

SCHEDULE

Conditions subject to which this licence is granted

1. This licence shall remain in force until 31st May 1998 except as hereinafter provided.
2. No fish other than salmon and rainbow trout shall be bred and handled at the said rearing unit.
3. The Licensee shall comply with such instructions as the Minister may issue from time to time for the control of all fish culture activities concerned in the operation of the rearing unit.
4. The Licensee shall make adequate arrangements to ensure that the cages shall not obstruct the passage of migratory fish and shall take all measures to prevent the escape of salmon and rainbow trout from the cages and shall carry out any instructions as may be required from time to time by the Minister.
5. The stock of fish held at the said rearing unit shall not exceed such quantity as may be specified by the Minister from time to time and will not in any event exceed a standing stock of 133,000 rainbow trout fingerlings or 80,000 salmon smolts.
6. Records shall be kept at the said rearing unit farm of all fish stripped, bred, held and handled at the said rearing unit farm and of all sales of fish from it and such records shall be available for inspection at all reasonable times by any inspector appointed for the purpose of Part X of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959.
7. The Licensee shall furnish to the Department of the Marine and Natural Resources, (Coastal Zone Administration Division) Leeson Lane, Dublin 2 such returns from the records kept at the said rearing unit as may be required from time to time by the Minister.
8. Salmon ova, fry, fingerlings or smolts and rainbow trout ova, fry or fingerlings shall not be sold or disposed of to any person or in any way transferred outside the said rearing unit save in accordance with the written permission of the Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources.
9. The said rearing unit and all premises used in connection with operations carried on at the rearing unit farm shall be open to inspection at any time by any authorised officer within the meaning of the Fisheries Acts.
10. The Licensee shall carry out such water quality monitoring and provide such data relating to such monitoring as may be requested from time to time by the Department of the Marine and Natural Resources (Coastal Zone Administration) at the above address.


11. The Licensee shall notify the Department of the Marine and Natural Resources (Coastal Zone Administration) at the above address within forty-eight hours of the appearance or suspected appearance of any disease at the said rearing unit or abnormal losses or mortalities and shall send samples to the Fish Health Unit, Abbotstown, Castleknock, Co. Dublin, in a prescribed manner as and when requested to do so and shall comply with any directions as to the treatment, disposal or destruction of stocks of fish at the said rearing unit in the interests of safeguarding the stocks of fish in the State.
12. The Licensee shall make arrangements for the provision of a lime pit for the disposal of dead fish. All dead fish shall be disposed of in a manner approved by the Minister and acceptable to the Local Authority.
13. The Licensee shall make adequate arrangements for the hygienic operation of the said rearing unit (including selection and preparation of food, treatment and disposal of effluent) and in that connection shall comply with any directions which may be issued from time to time by the Minister.
14. All chemicals and antibiotics used in the fishery shall be used in accordance with instructions issued by the Minister from time to time.
15. The Licensee shall keep records of all drugs (including antibiotics), chemicals and disinfectants with which the fish have been treated, including quantities and times of use.
16. The Licensee shall notify the Department of the Marine and Natural Resources (Coastal Zone Administration Division), at the above address within twenty-four hours of any escapes of fish from the fishery and shall keep records of fish escaped, including types and year classes and shall make these records available to the Department on request.
17. Such precautions shall be taken as the Minister may specify from time to time, in relation to (a) introduction of the salmon ova, fry, fingerlings or smolts or of rainbow trout ova, fry, or fingerlings for stocking the rearing unit, including disease free certification, in appropriate terms, and (b) the adaptation of methods of operation or type of installation (e.g. use of concrete ponds).
18. The Licensee shall fit adequate anti-predator netting on rearing unit structures so as to prevent predation and the possible spreading of disease by predators and shall comply with any directions which may be issued by the Minister from time to time in that regard.
19. This licence shall indemnify and keep indemnified the State, the Minister, their officers, servants or agents against actions, loss, claims, damages, costs, expenses and demands arising in any manner whatsoever in connection with the construction, maintenance or use of any aquaculture structures, apparatus or equipment in the exercise of rights granted under this licence.

20. In the event of neglect or abandonment of the fish, the Minister shall take such action as he thinks fit to dispose of the fish including revocation of licence.
21. The Minister shall be at liberty at any time to revoke or amend this licence if he considers that it is in the public interest to do so or if he is satisfied that there has been a breach of any condition specified in the licence. Any such revocation or amendment shall be subject to the provisions of Section 15 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959.
22. This licence is valid only so long as the layout of the rearing unit conforms to the plans duly approved in Paragraph 1 of this licence,.
23. This licence may be amended or revoked as provided by Section 15 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959.
24. This licence is not to be construed as authorising the Licensee in any way to interfere with or infringe the rights of any other person.
25. This licence is not transferable.



AQUACULTURE LICENCE

AGREEMENT made the 13th April, 1995 between the Minister for the Marine (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister"), of the one part and Seastream Ltd. whose registered address is at Mulranny, Westport, Co. Mayo (hereinafter referred to as the "the Licensee") of the other part whereby the Minister in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Act, 1933 hereby grants onto the Licensee licence to use and occupy that part of the Foreshore of Clew Bay, Co. Mayo, referred to in the Schedule and delineated on the map annexed hereto and thereon coloured red for the purpose of mooring four (4) Turmec cages 12 m x 12m x 7m having a total capacity of 4032 cubic metres for the cultivation of salmon and rainbow trout on the terms and conditions following:

1. This licence shall remain in force until the 6th day of November, 2001 except as hereinafter provided.
2. The Licensee shall pay to the Minister through the Department of the Marine (Aquaculture Section), Leeson Lane, Dublin 2, the annual sum of £50 such payment to be made on the 7th day of November in every year during the continuance of this licence.
3. The Licensee shall use that part of the foreshore, the subject matter of this licence, for the mooring of fish cages as detailed above in connection with the cultivation of salmon and rainbow trout and for no other purpose whatsoever.
4. The Licensee shall at all times during the continuance of this licence keep the said cages in a good and proper state of repair and condition to the satisfaction of the Minister and ensure that they will not be injurious to navigation, the adjacent lands or the public interest.
5. The Licensee shall ensure that the licensed area and the area around the development shall be kept clear of all redundant structures, waste products or materials associated with the development.
6. The Licensee shall cause each cage to be fitted to the satisfaction of the Minister with a low intensity, battery powered, yellow coloured flashing light and a radar reflector for the safety of navigation during the hours of darkness and reduced visibility.

7. *The Licensee shall comply with any directions which may be issued by the Minister from time to time in that regard.*
8. *The Licensee shall ensure that each cage shall bear the licence number AQ 166.*
9. *The Licensee shall fit adequate anti-predator netting on all cages and shall comply with any directions which may be issued by the Minister from time to time in that regard.*
10. *The Licensee shall indemnify and keep indemnified the State, the Minister, their officers, agents and employees against all actions, loss, claims, damages, costs, expenses and demands arising in any manner whatsoever in connection with the construction, maintenance or use of the said cages or in the exercise of the permission hereby granted.*
11. *The Minister shall be at liberty at any time to terminate this licence by giving to the Licensee three weeks previous notice in writing ending on any day and upon determination of such notice the licence and permission hereby granted shall be deemed to be revoked and withdrawn without the liability for the payment of any compensation by the Minister to the Licensee.*
12. *The Licensee shall if so required by the Minister and, within three weeks after receipt of such notice or on determination of this licence from any other cause at its expense remove the said cages to the satisfaction of the Minister and if the Licensee refuses or fails to do so the Minister may cause the said cages to be removed and shall be entitled to recover from the Licensee as a simple contract debt in any court of competent jurisdiction all costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with the removal and restoration, and the Licensee shall take such steps as the Minister may specify in order to secure compliance with this condition.*
13. *In the event of the breach, non-performance or non-observance by the Licensee of any of the conditions herein contained the Minister may forthwith terminate this licence without prior notice to the Licensee.*

14. *Any notice to be given by the Minister may be transmitted through the Post Office addressed to the Licensee at its last known address.*
15. *This licence replaces Foreshore Licence dated 7th November, 1991 granted to Sea Queen Ltd. and assigned to BP Nutrition Ireland Ltd. on 27th January 1994.*
