Country of Origin

1. Ireland is free from Foot and Mouth Disease, Lumpy Skin Disease, Pest de Petits Ruminants, Vesicular Stomatitis, Rabies, Anthrax and Bluetongue.
2. Ireland is officially free from *Brucella melitensis* and *Brucellosis abortus*. There have been no reported cases of *Brucella ovis* during the last three years.

The Farms of Origin

3. There have been no cases of scrapie officially recorded on the farms of origin during the last six years.
4. The farms of origin are not restricted for tuberculosis.

The exported animals

5. The animals have been reared in the country of origin since their birth and do not come from countries not authorised by Libya.
6. The animals do not show any signs of contagious or infectious diseases.
7. The animals are not to be slaughtered under any disease eradication programme .
8. The animals are not being transported with sheep of a different health status and the means of transport has been cleaned and disinfected prior to the loading of the animals.
