Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2279 of 11 December 2017 amending Annexes II, IV, VI, VII and VIII to Regulation (EC) No 767/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council on placing on the market and use of feed

RE: Notification of amendments to Regulation (EC) No 767/2009

The Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (DAFM) wish to bring to your attention amendments to Annexes II, IV, VI, VII and VIII of Regulation (EC) No 767/2009 on the placing on the market and use of feed, as laid down in Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2279 attached herein for your information. The consolidated version of Regulation (EC) No 767/2009, as amended by Regulation (EU) 2017/2279, can be accessed using the following link: <http://eur-lex.europa.eu/advanced-search-form.html>.

You are advised to read and familiarise yourself with the complete consolidated Regulation and ensure that all marketing and use practices are in compliance with the amended requirements. Amendments include:

- Amendments to the existing text of Annexes II, IV & VIII;
- The introduction of new text in Annexes VI & VII.

In recognition of particular challenges associated with the labelling of feed additive compounds which have been discussed between DAFM and Industry, your attention is drawn to the following new text under Annex VI and VII(1):

'The labelling particulars shall be indicated in accordance with the legal act authorising the feed additives in question.

The added amount referred to in the first paragraph shall be the amount of the feed additive except where the legal act authorising the respective feed additive indicates a substance in the column "minimum/maximum content". In the latter case, the added amount shall be the amount of that substance.'

For example: the labelling of Trace Elements requires the following declarations:

1. The specific name of the additive (the compound);
2. The identification number;
3. The added amount of the element (not of the compound);
4. The name of the functional group or the category.
