**European Communities (Authorization, Placing on the Market,
Use and Control of Plant Protection Products) (Amendment) (No. 4)
Regulations 2004**

I, Joe Walsh, Minister for Agriculture and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), for the purpose of giving effect to Commission Directive 2004/60/EC of 23 April 2004¹, Commission Directive 2004/62/EC of 26 April 2004², and Commission Directive 2004/71/EC of 28 April 2004³ hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Authorization, Placing on the Market, Use and Control of Plant Protection Products) (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 2004 and shall come into force in respect of Quinoxifen on 1 March 2005, in respect of Mepanipyrim on 1 April 2005 and in respect of Pseudomonas chlororaphis on 1 April 2005.
2. The European Communities (Authorization, Placing on the Market, Use and Control of Plant Protection Products) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 83 of 2003) are amended, in Regulation 2(1), by substituting for “Directive of 1991” the following-

These Regulations give effect to Commission Directive 2004/60/EC of 23 April 2004, Commission Directive 2004/62/EC of 26 April 2004 and Commission Directive 2004/71/EC of 28 April 2004. These Regulations, which amend Council Directive 91/414/EEC concerning the placing of plant protection products on the market provide for the inclusion of the active substances Quinoxifen, Mepanipyrim and *Pseudomonas chlororaphis* to Annex I to Council Directive 91/414/EEC.
